## Streetcar Station Repairs Begin Feb. 12



Beginning Monday, Feb. 12, the City of Cincinnati and the Southwest Ohio Regional Transit Authority are making minor repairs at streetcar stations related to the concrete and the ticket vending machines.

It is expected that each station repair will take between two and four days to complete, during which time the station will be closed to the public. No more than three of the 18 stations in the system will be affected at any one time.
